The best season of the year, for the hunters then off course.

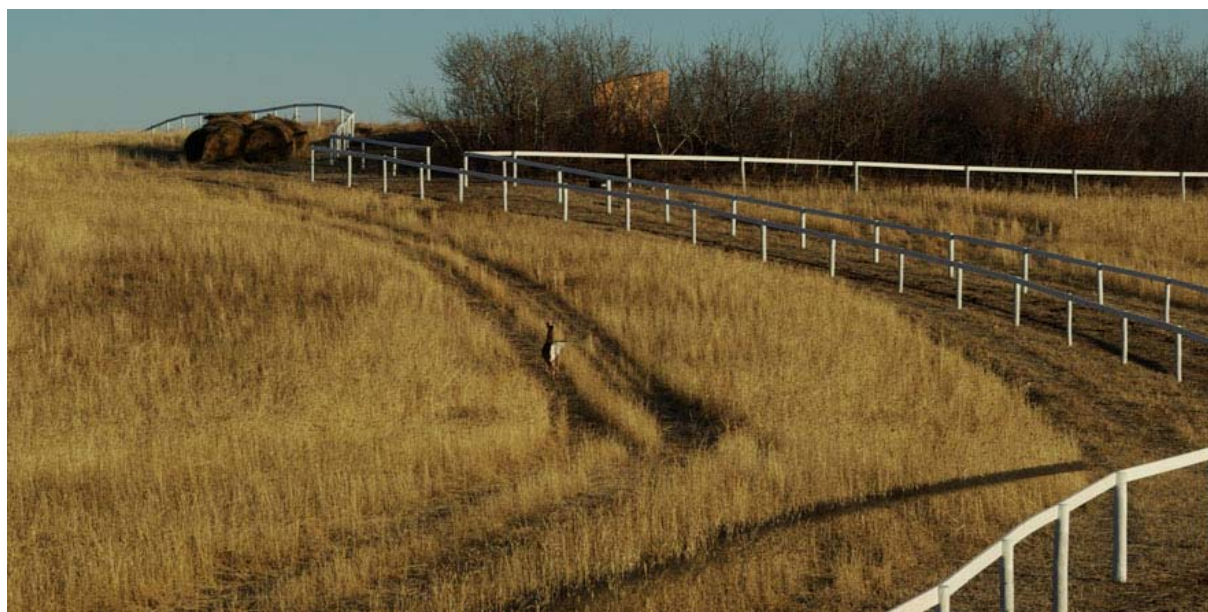
Every animal has their own different hunting period and the same goes for the type of weapon like a hunting rifle or a crossbow for example.
